Policy: Power of Attorney Active Assist

Purpose

To provide a policy for when a Power of Attorney is activated and NSW Trustee & Guardian is taking up appointment as Attorney.

Policy statement

Prior to activating the Power of Attorney, NSW Trustee & Guardian must have the customer's written request or medical evidence that the customer lacks capacity.

A delegated officer of NSW Trustee & Guardian approves the activation of the Power of Attorney and signs the Power of Attorney document accepting appointment on behalf of NSW Trustee & Guardian.

Where the customer is capable, NSW Trustee & Guardian is to act on the customer's instructions. If the customer is incapable, NSW Trustee & Guardian is to act in the best interest of the customer.
